An easy sailing standard combined with a remarkable amount of space

Relaxed family sailing with as little manoeuvring as possible: standard mast with angled boom for easy sail storage, self-tacking jib for easy tacking, 1 single winch on the port side of the coachroof – cruising within everyone's reach!

This simplicity is combined with spacious accommodation that offers everyone a high level of comfort.

The steps along the entire length of the hull optimise the volume of the cockpit while emphasising the slender silhouette.

Spacious helm stations:

The elimination of the backstay frees up the helm station, and along with the 65cm-long lifting seats, result in visible improvements to comfort and ergonomics.

Large cockpit:

The 2 long bench seats, which are wider near the companionway, provide ample seating capacity, while the cockpit's great width makes moving around easy. A high platform closes off the cockpit at the stern, so that the space is well protected and safe.

A large access to the sea: thanks to the width of the cockpit and the lifting helm seats, you have a very wide passageway to the swim platform at anchor.

Its size is similar to the Oceanis 40.1, making it a real advantage!

Customised comfort:

Cockpit upholstery, sprayhood, bimini, deluxe cockpit table, side access gates, extra hatches for the aft cabins, Iro-deck cockpit floor, etc. The cruiser can be transformed to cater to the preferences and requirements of each individual user.

Customised sail plan:

2 different packs are available to improve speed and sensations at the helm and to satisfy customer expectations: Upwind/Downwind Pack and First Line Pack.

Both have 3 extra winches, 2 of which are close to the helm station, as well as a stemhead to add headsails ideal for light air.

In terms of sail area, the self-tacking jib has been replaced by a genoa with the Upwind/Downwind pack (+ 7 m² sail area).

With the First Line pack, the sails are optional and the cut of the square-top mainsail as well as the flatdeck furling genoa deliver an upwind sail area of 73.50 m², increasing the sail area by 13 m² compared to the standard version.

A **deck hardware upgrade** for the most demanding sailors.

With this upgrade, the boat can be fitted with Performance sails: **22.50%** more surface area compared to the standard version.

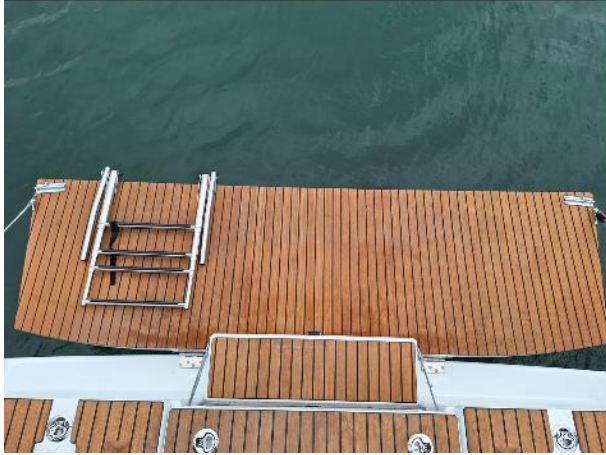

Spaces and Comfort:

A real feeling of space thanks to the hull shape, pushing the boundaries of the interior!

A very spacious starboard saloon seating 6 people faces a long galley to starboard.

Both the owner's and guests' cabins are comfortable, and the 3-cabin 2-shower room version even means that the owner can have an **ensuite shower room**, which is unusual on a cruiser this size.

On the 2-cabin version, you can opt for an **extra-large shower cubicle** in the starboard aft shower room.

Carefully studied ergonomics, a selection of upholstery, large berths, light, ventilation and headroom all contribute to a **premium lifestyle on board!**

A large storage locker at the bottom of the companionway is ideal for cruising.

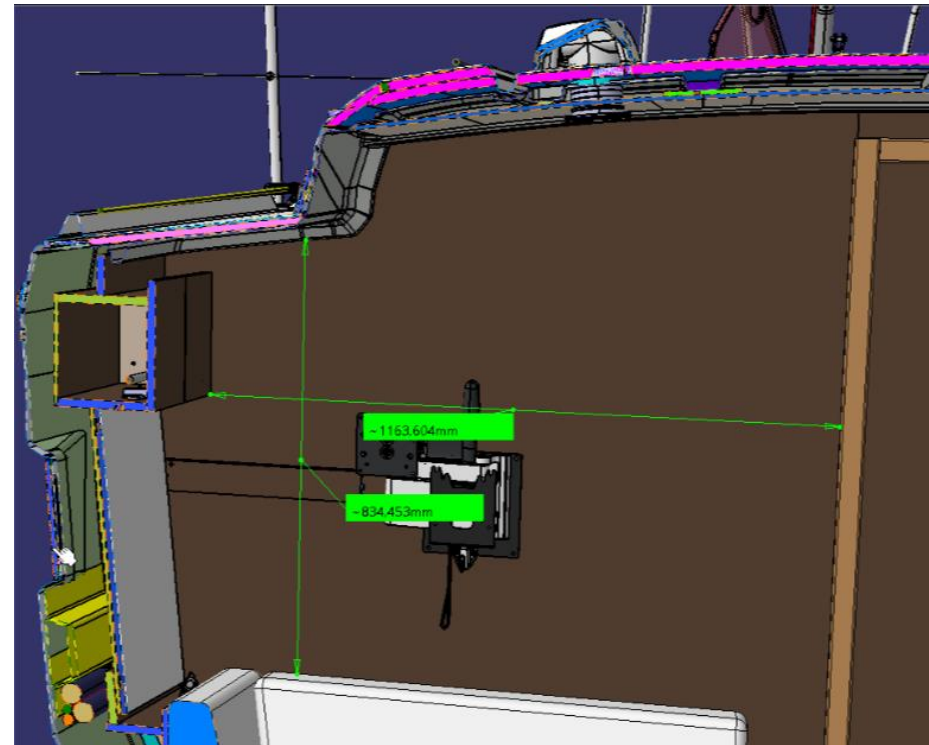

A large attractive space for the owner:

The cabin is bathed in natural light and very well ventilated with its 3 deck hatches.

The large double bed offers a very good sleep:
2.07 m x 1.61 m x 0.90 m / 6'9" x 5'3" x 2'11"

2 hanging lockers on either side of the hull

Indirect lighting under the overhead shelves creating a very pleasant atmosphere

Bed head with open storage, direct lighting and USB socket for recharging mobile devices

Beige padded lining along the hull with a Comfort trim

Interiors: a premium owner's-cabin version

3-cabin version with 2 shower rooms with a very comfortable layout

An ideal layout that preserves the owner's privacy

The hull design allows a private shower room to be integrated on the port side of the cabin without affecting the size of the double berth (2.10 m x 1.38 m / 6'11" x 4'6').

The shower room has a washbasin, 1 wall unit with mirror, 1 mixer tap with shower attachment and a manual toilet. T10 deck hatch ventilation

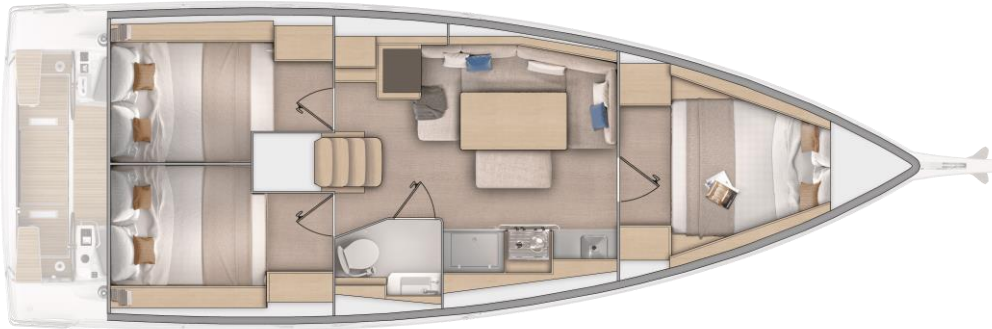

Ideal for people who enjoy long cruises, it provides space for a workshop on the starboard side, easy to get to from the saloon, and a huge sail locker.

On the port side, the bed is now bigger offering a king-size berth (2.00 m x 1.82 m / 6'7" x 6').

In this version, you can also choose a [spacious shower space seamlessly integrated into the starboard aft washroom](#), instead of the standard workshop setup. The shower features a wooden seat for the same level of comfort as a Yacht. Removable rail for drying all-weather gear
